UPCOMING EVENT- Our Holy Family Catholic United Financial Good4Service project is scheduled for Thursday, July 14th, @ 5 pm.

This year we will be applying a treatment solution to the tombstones to enhance the look of our cemetery. The treatment is applied by either spraying or "painting " the tombstone to remove the lichen and algae that has formed over the years. This takes approximately three weeks to work. No scrubbing of the stone is necessary. It cannot be applied in direct sunlight as it dries too quickly therefore we are starting at 5 pm. We are asking for volunteers to help with this project as there are about 300 tombstones. More details to come.
